

Albert Edward Harrison was born on the 2<sup>nd</sup> February 1894 and was baptised in this Church on the 1<sup>st</sup> April 1894. The Harrison family lived in Farley Green.

Albert joined the 1st/5th Battalion, The Queen's (Royal West Surrey Regiment). The Battalion sailed for India from Southampton on the 29<sup>th</sup> October 1914 and landed in Bombay on the 2<sup>nd</sup> December 1914. They later sailed to Basra in Iraq landing on the 7<sup>th</sup> December 1915.

By November 1917 the Battalion were in Ramadi, west of Baghdad. Albert died on the 1<sup>st</sup> November, probably from sickness. He was aged 23. He is buried in North Gate War Cemetery, Baghdad.

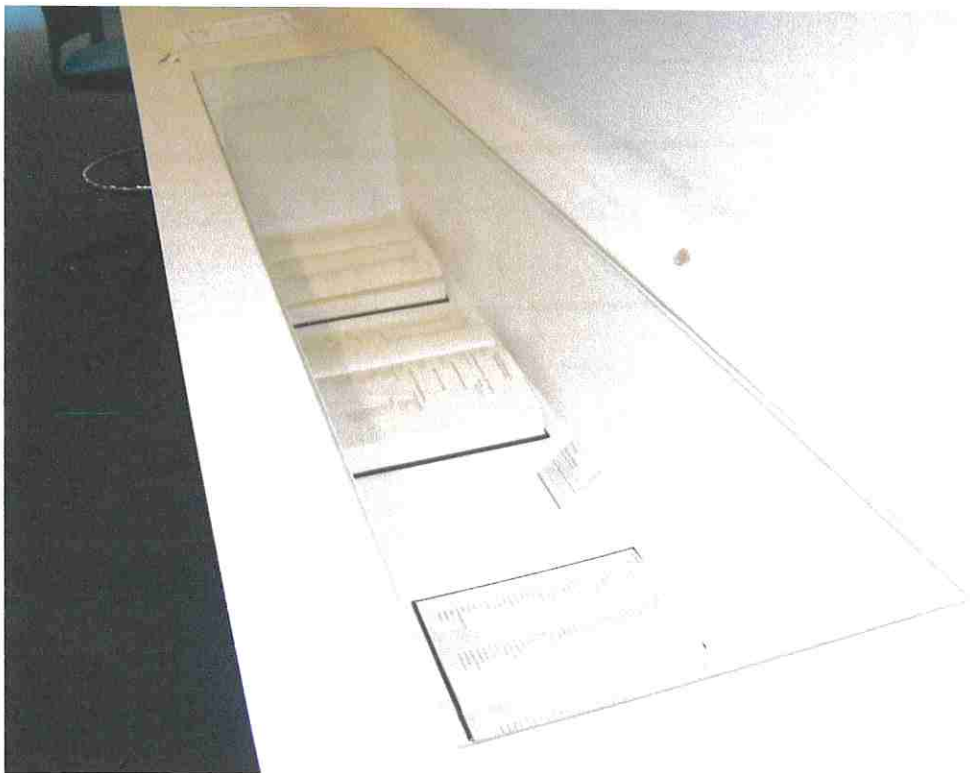
