Arthur served in the Royal Munster Fusiliers.He died on the 31<sup>st</sup>.January 1916 from illness following the Gallipoli campaign.He was aged 34.He is buried in the Chatby Military Cemetery,Alexandria,Egypt.

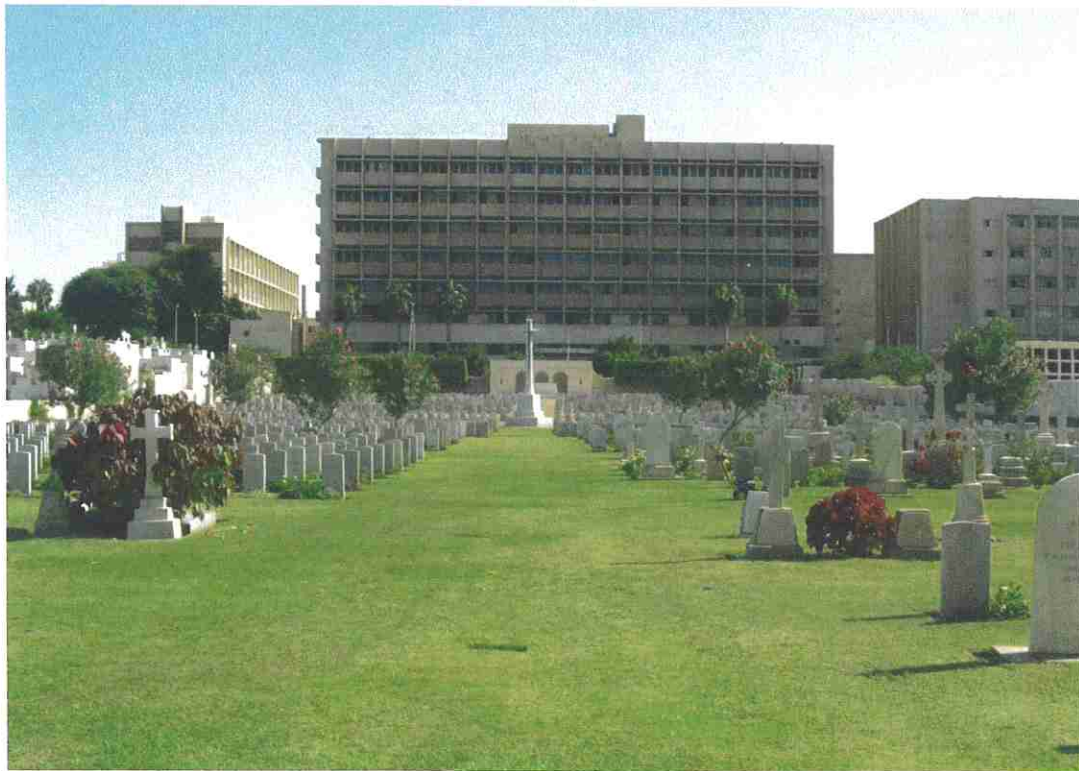

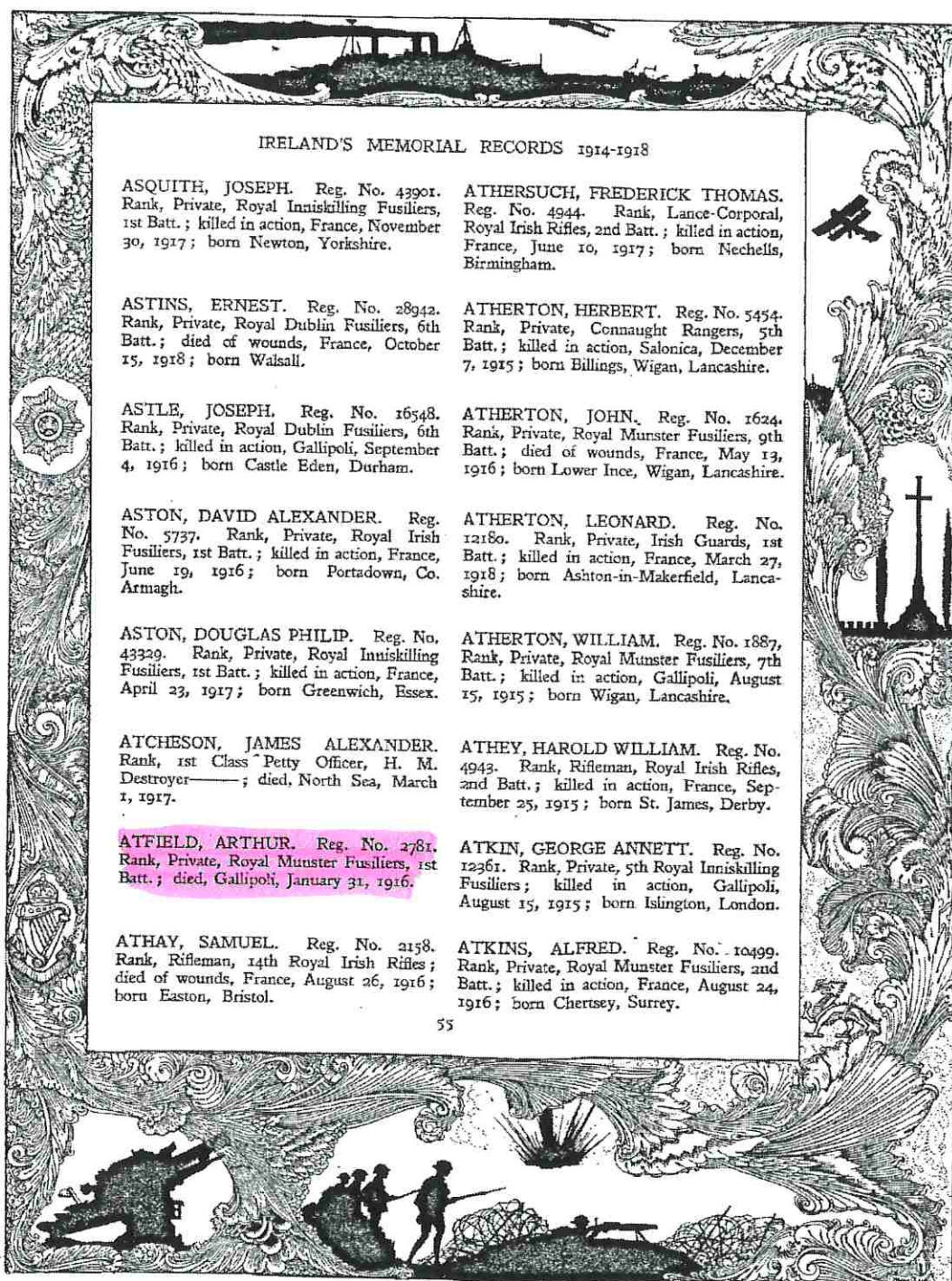

ASTINS, ERNEST. Reg. No. 28942. Rank, Private, Royal Dublin Fusiliers, 6th Batt.; died of wounds, France, October 15, 1918; born Walsall.

ASTLE, JOSEPH. Reg. No. 16548. Rank, Private, Royal Dublin Fusiliers, 6th Batt.; killed in action, Gallipoli, September 4, 1916; born Castle Eden, Durham.

ASTON, DAVID ALEXANDER. Reg. No. 5737. Rank, Private, Royal Irish Fusiliers, 1st Batt.; killed in action, France, June 19, 1916; born Portadown, Co. Armagh.

ATHERTON, JOHN. Reg. No. 1624. Rank, Private, Royal Munster Fusiliers, 9th Batt.; died of wounds, France, May 13, 1916; born Lower Ince, Wigan, Lancashire.

ATHERTON, LEONARD. Reg. No. 12180. Rank, Private, Irish Guards, 1st Batt.; killed in action, France, March 27, 1918; born Ashton-in-Makerfield, Lancashire.
