



Harry Styles was born on the 1<sup>st</sup>.May 1887 and was baptised in this Church on the 3<sup>rd</sup>.July 1887.

Harry joined the 2<sup>nd</sup>.Battalion,The Queen's (Royal West Surrey Regiment).The 2<sup>nd</sup>.Battalion landed at Zeebrugge on the 6<sup>th</sup>.October 1914.Harry was killed on the 16<sup>th</sup>.May 1915 during the Battle of Festubert.He was aged 28.He has no grave but is remembered on the Le Touret Memorial.
