

James Moss was born on the 26th.February 1882 in Heage,Derbyshire.On the 1911 Census he was living at Smithwood Common with his wife Edith and their two small children .Smithwood Common was at that time in the parish of Albury.

He enlisted in the 2nd.Battalion Grenadier Guards.He was killed in action on the Somme on the 27th.September 1916.He was aged 34.He is buried in Heilly Station Cemetery,Mericourt L'Abbe,Somme,France.He is remembered on our War Memorial and that of Cranleigh.


