

William Arthur Pauffley was born on the 6<sup>th</sup>.September 1894 and was baptised in this Church on the 3<sup>rd</sup>.March 1895.On the 1901 Census William was living with his parents and two sisters in Guildford Lane.On the 1911 Census he was living in Bisley working as a farm labourer.

William enlisted in The Rifle Brigade.He was killed on the 30<sup>th</sup>.October 1914 at the Battle of Armentieres.He was aged 21.He has no grave but is remembered on the Ploegsteert Memorial.

William's name does not appear on our War Memorial.A possible explanation is that on the 1911 Census his mother was living in the Guildford Workhouse and his two sisters were living in a workhouse run foster home in Guildford Road,Guildford.There is no trace of his father so it is possible with his family in the workhouse he was forgotten.
