



Mid 19c. Georgian style granary, timber framed, weatherboarded, with hipped tiled roof on replacement stables, of brick & concrete.

Two unglazed windows with diamond mullions. The walls internally were originally boarded, but are now covered with galvanized sheeking, as is the floor. The ceiling was once plastered. Wall plate same level all round. Central truss with principal rafters, tie beam and collar. Common rafters halved together (no ridge board); clasped purlins. Collars also acted as ceiling joists. Originally had four timber grain bins.
