



The centre of a terrace of three shops with accommodation over. c.1840

Stone to ground floor - ironstone, clunch, sandstone - ^{and flint} tile hung above. Gabled. Two storeys with attic and basement kitchens.

Decorative "Pugin" chimneys to East, diamondflues (? rebuilt) to West. Decorative carved bargeboards. 'Old Post Office' jetted to West.

Doorheads four centred and form part of a unit with the adjoining windows.

Stairs in "Not the old Pharmacy" said to differ, with stairs up and down on opposite sides of the house. "old Post Office" had breel over projecting into garden - not known if other houses had one.

Green pool roofs with purlins above collar, supported by raking struts down to it. Ridge board
