



A pair of semi-detached cottages c. 1830, brick, with gabled tiled roof, end chimneys with bread ovens and added lean-to, now one

Probably built by Henry Drummond for two estate workers. Brick front has brick drip hoods over doors and windows. Back covered by new lean-to, no not known if hoods there. Wall at back 80' (22m.) deep, now dry. Western house still has timber and tiled privy. Both bread ovens gone.

Not shown on map of 1822, but on Tithe Map of 1839. Incised brick by front door - D.L. 1832.
