



A late 16 C. 2 bay house with end smoke bay, added bays and later additions. Timber framed with gabled tiled roof, the additions of stone. Square panels, straight down braces.

Roof always gabled, rafters butted and pegged to purlins. No principal rafters. 2 queen posts to each truss. Wattle & daub partitions up to collar. Two rooms up and two rooms down, with possible lean-to to S. or W. Spire beams chamfered with curved stepped stops, plain joints. Strain rope beside the hearth with sloping plastered ceiling over to protect them from the smoke. Chamfered spire beam suggests a parlour rather than service room. Attico partly boarded.

Single storey kitchen wing added in stone, later built up. Bread oven projects into garden with lean-to tiled roof.

Dairy probably added early 17 C. - square framing. Rafters run behind purlin. Long chiselled carpenter's marks.
