



Early 16c. 2 bay timber framed open hall house with internal jetty, low posts, clasped purlins, tiled roof, hipped with gables one end, gabled the other. Wind braces. Originally wattle & daub infill, now partly clad in brick, and stone with ironstone galleting.

One bay hearth room, with jetty, open to roof, one bay service room(s) from which stairs rose. Late 16. smoke hood, into which brick chimney was built later. Bacon lgr. Hall floored over. Doors moved. Late 17c. unheated parlour & room over. Stairs moved. Bread oven. 19c. upholsterer's room added with catslide roof. 17c. addition = originally stone lean-to, brick clad and later built up.
