



A medieval rectorial tilth / glebe barn, possibly late 15c. contemporary with earliest part of Rectory. 5 bays, timber framed with owl joints, long passing braces, originally lipped with vertical green paint. One pair doors only. N. end floored. Probably originally clad with wattles, now weatherboarded. S. end later partitioned off with inserted floor, for stable (or cowhouse) below, and later chauffeur's quarters over. Modern gabled roof, tiled, replacement after fire.

Dendro dated 1468/69
