



An early 17 C. end chimney house of two bays, timber framed with gabled tiled roof and outshot.

Slight framing in square panels with straight tension braces. Nogging to first floor is sandstone, the south front has been faced with brick at ground floor level with tile capping. Chimney of sandstone with brick quoins and brickwork in English bond over. Two shafts set away from wall. Bread oven remains, but no access, tiles from chimney carried down in catwalk over bread oven.

Outshot lower, with ironstone base with sandstone over, possibly with catwalk roof, later built up.

Hearth room has chequerboard spire beam and plain joists. Clasped purlin roof, 2 Queen posts, inclined struts over collar. Rooms celled at collar level - no attic.

Very similar to "The Cottage", over the road.
