



A late 16c. 4 bay timber framed house with smoke bay and entrance at end, with adjacent building now incorporated, additions to link them together and a Victorian wing parallel to the original house with 3 sided end. Walls now white painted brick, tile hung above, with chimney built in smoke bay.

East end half hipped with one straight tension brace. Chimney set behind ridge. Windows cut through wall plate & form dormers. Two vertical Queen posts at East end. House built into hillside.

Joints chamfered & exposed in bay next to hearth, covered in other two. Rafters flat, pegged, clasped purlins, 2 Queen posts

Additions include another building, linked, a Gothic wing and ironstone grotto, and another room with cellar under
