In the name of god Amen: the mynthe day of June in ye yere of our lord god one Thousand and six hundred and Twentye I Alice Stillwell of Aldbury in the Countee of Surrey widdowe beinge sicke in bodye but thankes be given to almighty god in good and perfecte Remembraunce I doe here ordaine and make this my last will and Testamente in manner and fowrme followinge In primis I will and bequeathe my soule to the almighty god my maker and Redemer trusshinge to bee saved by the deare and mirites of his only sonne and my only saviour(?) Jesus Christe and by no other meanes and my bodye to be buried in Christian buriall at ye discretion of my Executors hereafter named Item I will and bequeath unto Dorothy Stillwell my daughter fortye pounds of lawfull monny of Englande to be payed by my Executors hereundernamed the one halfe of it w(i)thin three monthes after my Decesse the other halfe of it w(i)thin nyxe monthes after my Decesse Item I will and bequeath unto Margery Stillwell my daughter fortye pounds of lawfull monny of Englande to be payed w(i)thin one wholle yere nexte after my decease by my Executors here under named Item I give unto Thomas Rysbridger my Eldest sonne five shillinges and to each of his three sonnes five shillinges apiece to be payed to them by my Executors hereunder named w(i)thin three monthes after my decease Item I give unto Frances Rysbridger ye daughter of William Rysbridger of Aldbury in ye Countee of Surrey yeoman Ten shillinges of lawfull monny of England w(i)thin three monthes after my decease to be payed by my Executors Item I give unto Katherine Rysbridger my goddaughter ye daughter of Thomas Rysbridger of Aldbury afforsaid five shillinges to be payed by my Executors w(i)thin three monthes after my decease Item I give unto evry servaunt y(er)t is in ye house of William Rysbridger afforsaid at ye tyme of my decease each of them xij^d to be payed w(i)thin three monthes after my decease Item I give unto ye poore people of ye parische of Wetley ^s and to ye poore people of ye parische of Aldbury ^s to be payed w(i)thin three monthes after my decease Item I give unto Dorothy Stillwell my daughter and unto Margery Stillwell my daughter one fetherbed and one great fether bolster and two Coverlets and one blancket and one flocke bed to be delievered unto them and equally devided betweenne them w(i)thin three monthes after my decease The Residue of my goodes and Chattelles whatsoeuer after my debts and legacies payed my funerall Expences satisfied and my bodye decently buried I give unto William Rysbridger

to(hi)ch I doe make my whole and sole Executor of this my
present last will and Testament and I doe make and ordaine
william bixley of Aldburye my Lourige Friend To be overseer
to this my last will and Testament and I give him for
his paines five Shillings over and above all such Expenses
as he shall be at and in witness whereof y(har) This is my last
will and Testament I have hereto set my hand and seale
given the day and yeare firste above written
