In the name of god Amen: the nyghte day of June in ye yeare of our lord god one thousand six hundred and Twentye I Alice Stillwell of Aldbery in the Countye of Surrey widdowe beinge sicke in bodye but thankes be given to allmightye god in good and perfecte Remembrance I doe here ordaine and make this my last will and Teastamente in manner and fowrme followinge In pryncipall I will and bequeathe my soule to the allmightye god my maker and Redeemer trustinge to be saved by the deathe and mirites of his only sonne and my only Sav<sup>our</sup>(?) Jesus Christe and by no other meanes and my bodye to be buried in Christian buriall at ye discretion of my Executors hereafter named Item I will and bequeath unto dorothee Stillwell my daughter fortye poundes of lawfull monny of Englande to be payed by my Executors hereunder named the one halfe of it w(i)thin three monthes after my Decease the other halfe of it w(i)thin nyxe monthes after my Decease Item I <sup>will</sup> and bequeathe unto margery Stillwell my daughter fortye poundes of lawfull monny of England to be payed w(i)thin one wholle yeare nexte after my decease by my Executors here under named Item I give unto Thomas Stillwell my Eldest sonne five shillinges and to each of his three sonns five shillinges apeece to be payed to them by my Executors here under named w(i)thin three monthes after my decease Item I give unto frances Risbridger ye daughter of William Risbridger of Aldbery in ye County of Surrey yeoman Ten shillinges of lawfull monny of England w(i)thin three monthes after my decease to be payed by my Executors Item I give unto Kathrine Risbridger my goddaughter ye daughter of Thomas Risbridger of Aldbery afforesaid five shillinges to be payed by my Executors w(i)thin three monthes after my decease Item I give unto every servannt y<sup>e</sup> (at) is in ye house of William <sup>Risbridger</sup> afforesaid at ye time of my decease each of them xij<sup>d</sup> to be payed w(i)thin three monthes after my decease Item I give unto ye poore people of ye parische of Wetley x<sup>s</sup> and to ye poore people of ye p(ar)ishe of Aldbery x<sup>s</sup> to be payed w(i)thin three monthes after my decease Item I give unto Dorothee Stillwell my daughter and unto margery Stillwell my daughter one featherbed and one great feather bolster and two Coverlets and one blencket and one flocke bed to be delvered unto them and equally devided betweene <sup>them</sup> w(i)thin three monthes after my decease The Residue of my goodes and Chattelles whatsoever after my depts and legacies paid my funerall Expenses satisfied and my bodye decently buried I give unto William Risbridger

 w(h)ich I doe make my whole and sole Executors of this my  
 present last will and Testament and I doe make and ordaine  
William Bixley of Alburye my Lovinge Friend to be overseer  
 to this my last will and Testament and I give him for  
 his paines five shillings over and above all such Expenses  
 as he shall be at and in witness whereof y<sup>(that)</sup> This is my last  
 will and Testament I have hereto set my hand and seale  
 given the day and yeare first above written
