 fortythe yere of ye reigne of o(u)r Sovereigne Lodie Elizabeth
 by ye grace of God quene of England France & Irelande deffendress
 of the Faithe etc, I Edwarde Aburne of Weston in the p(ar)ishe of
 Aldberie in the Countie of Surre(y) howsbandman beinge sicke
 in bodye but of good remembrance thanks be to Allmightie God
 doe ordeyne & make this my laste will in wryghteinge In manner
 & forme followeing First I bequeathe my soule to Allmightie
 God my maker & creator believeinge to be saved by the verritts
 & deathe of Jesus Christe mye sole saviour & redemer & my bodie
 to be buried in ye Churchyarde of Aldberie Item I gyve unto Agnis
 my wyf my house & teneme(n)t wherein I doe nowe dwell w(ith) all
 the Landes belongeth to the name to have & to howlde to her & her
 Assignees for & dureinge the whole tyme untill my Sonne Johne
 shall come to ye full adge of Six & Twentie yeres, But my meaneing
 is y(h)at if my saide Sonne Doe die before y(h)at Adge without Issue of his
 Bodie Lawfullie begotten, then my wyf shall have the same howse
 dureinge her Life, And after her deceasse I gyve the same howse
 to my dawghter Roberta & to the heires of her bodie Lawfullie begotten
 And if she happen to die withoute Suche Issue then I gyve the same
 howse w(ith) thappurtena(n)ces unto my nephue Johne Chittie & to his
 heires for ever, Item I gyve unto Agnis my wife all my goodes
 & Cattells to bringe my bodie honestlie to ye grounde & to paie my
 Debtes, & all the rest to remaine unto her whome I doe make ye sole
 executor of this my last w(ill) & testament(e) & my mynde is that yf my
 saide wife doe marrie, that then my overseers undervners shall have
 Avethoritie to Appointe unto my Childeren that shall Survive suche
 reasonable portions as in Conference shall be thoughte mete, And I
 desire my fryndes Johne Haynarde & Thomas Mabenke to
 be the overseers of this my will to see it executed & p(er)formed
 As my Truste is they will In witness whereof I gave sette my
 name the daie & yere above written

A Trewe Inventory of all the goods and Cattells of Edwarde Auburne late of Weston in the parish of Albury in the county of Surrey deceased veiwed and prayzed the xixth of Aprill in the xlith (41st) yere of the Raigne of our sovraigne Lady Elizabeth by the grace of God Quene of England France and Ireland defender of the fayth etc. Anno Dni 1599 by Roberte Cowper (ex) p(ar)son of Albury Willian Kishbridger of Shere Thomas Mabancke George Aldrige and John Haynarde :-

6 trugs, 6 wooden dishes. Pewter - 3 basins, 1 ewer, 4 platters
11 dishes, 5 saucers, 12 spoons, 4 pots 1 double salt, 2 cups
Brass - 2 pots, 3 kettles, 3 poonets, 2 candlesticks,
1 collander, 1 chafing dish.

In the outer chamber 1 bedstead & feather bed + furniture,
1 cupboard, 2 chests, 1 box, 1 leather covered chair.

In the chamber over the hall. 1 bedstead + feather bed + furniture
4 chests, 1 cupboard, 6 cushions, 1 warming pan, 1 pair
andirons of iron & brass.

Linens - 7 prs. sheets, 4 table cloths, 12 table napkins, 3 pillow cases

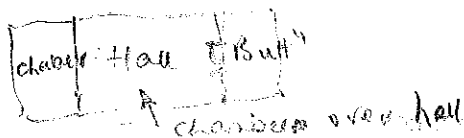
