In the name of God Amen the lyghte Daye of Apryll in the one and
fortythe yere of ye raigne of our Sovereigne Ladie Elizabeth
by ye grace of God quene of England France & Irelande defendress
of the Faithe etc, I Edwarde Aburne of Weston in the p(ar)ish of
Aldberie in the Countie of Surre(y) houesbandman beinge sick
in bodye but of good remembrance thankes be to Allmyghtie God
dye ordynance & make this my last will in wryghtinge In manner
& forme followinge First I beleave the my soule to Allmyghtie
God my maker & creator believinge to be saved by the merrits
& death of Jesus Christe mye sole saviour & redemer & my bodie
to be buried in ye Churche yarde of Aldberie Item I gyve vnto Agnes
my wyf my house & tenement(s) wherin I doe nowe dwelle w(i)t all
the Landes beloninge to the same to have & to hould to her & her
Assignees for & dureinge the wholle tyme until my sonne Johne
shall come to ye full age of Six & Twentie yeres, But my meaning
is y(h)a(t) if my sonde sonne Doe die before y(h)a(t) Age without issue of his
bodye Lawfullie begotten, Then my wif shall have the same house
dureinge her life, And after her deceasone I gyve the same house
to my daughter Roberta & to the heires of her bodye Lawfullie begotten
And If she happen to die without issue Then I gyve the same
house wittt appurtena(n)ces unto my neplue Johne Chittie & to his
heires for ever, Then I gyve unto Agnes my wife all my poodes
& Cattells to bringe my bodye honestlie to ye grounde & to paie my
detoltes, & all the rest to remayne unto her whome I doe make ye sole
executour of this my last will and reme(n)te & my mynde is That yf my
sonde wife doe marrie, Then the my overseers underwriten shall haue
Auctoritie to Appointe unto my childdren ther shalbe Surveye such
reasonable portions as in Conference shalbe thought mete, And I
desire my fyndes Johne Maynarde & Thomas Robenke to
be the overseers of this my will to see it executed & performed
As my truste is they will In witness whereof I have sette my
name the daye & yere above written

INVENTORY

In the Hall 1 table, 1 form, 2 stools, 1 cupboard, 1 chair
2 andirons, 1 iron crupper, 2 iron pot hangers.

In the Buttery 1 cupboard. 4 tubs, 1 kneading keve, 1 bolting hutch
6 trugs, 6 wooden dishes. Pewter - 3 basins, 1 ewer, 4 platters
11 dishes, 5 saucers, 12 spoons, 4 pots 1 double salt, 2 cups
Brass - 2 pots, 3 bellies, 3 posnets, 2 candlesticks,
1 collander, 1 chafing dish.

In the outer chamber 1 bedstead & feather bed + furniture,
1 cupboard, 2 chests, 1 box, 1 leather covered chair.

In the chamber over the hall. 1 bedstead & feather bed & furniture
4 chests, 1 cupboard, 6 cushions, 1 warming pan, 1 pair
andirons of iron & brass.

Linen - 7 prs. sheets, 4 table cloths, 12 Table napkins, 3 pillow
cases
1 Bill, 1 axe, 1 spitter - other husbandry tools
Clothes & money


