In the name of Amen the vith date of may 1589
I Will(iam) mathewe of Aldbervy in the Countie
of Surr(ey) Laborer beinge Sick in boode but
per(fect) remembrance thankes be givene unto
Allmighty God, doo ordene & make this my last
will & testament in maner and forme following
first I bequeath my Soule to Allmyghtie
God my maker believynge to be Saved by the
death of Jesus Christe his Son my Saviour
and redemer and my body to be buried in the
Churchyard of Aldbervye It(i)n I give unto my
cuscine Susen one Ewe, and A Lambe or Edward
Rustigiers It(e)m I gave unto my brother henrye
of Granlye the one halfe of all my goodes equally
to be divided and all the rest I gave unto Will(iam)
Frances(?) whome I make the Sole executor of
this my last will and testament etc. In witness
whereof I have sette my marke the daye and
yere first above written in the presence of
Robert Couper clarke parsonne of the said place.
