In the name of Amen the vi<sup>th</sup> daie of maij 1589  
I Will(iam) mathewe of Aldbery in the Countie  
of Surrey Laborer beinge Sicke in bodie but  
p(er)fect remembrance Thanks be given unto  
Allmighty God, doo ordeine & make this my last  
will & testamēt in mann(er) and forme following  
first I bequeath my Soule to Almighty  
God my maker believing to be Saved by the  
death of Jesus Christe his Sone my Saviour  
and redemer and my body to be buried in the  
Churchyard of Aldberye It(e)m I give unto my  
cusine Susan one Ewe, and A Lambe of Edward  
Risbrigers It(e)m I geve unto my brother henrye  
of Cranlye the one half. of all my goodes equally  
to be divided and all the rest I geve unto Will(iam)  
Frances(?) whom I make the Sole executor of  
this my last will and testamēt etc. In witness  
whereof I have sette my marke the daie and  
yere first above written in the presence of  
Robert Couper clarke parsonne of the said p(ar)ishe.
