In dei no(m)i(n)e amen. The seventene day of the month of Junij in the yere of our lord 1565, and in the seventh yere of the reaign of our soverayn lady Elizabeth grace of god of England France & Ireland quene defender of the etc. I Will(iam) p(ar)son of the p(ar)ishe of Aldbury (within the countie of Surrey being sick in my body, but yet of p(er)fect remembrance do make my last ^{will} in forme as followeth, First I bequeath my soule into the hands of my lord & saviour Jesu Christ by vertue of whose death & passion my full trust is to be saved, and my body to be buried in the churchyard of the said p(ar)ishe, and I give to the poore men boxe ther v $iiij^d$, Also I give to Thyllycent p(ar)son ij shepe, Also I give to Agnes Standlake one ewe & one lambe, Also I give to my daughter Cicely v $iiij^d$ and to Al(i)ce her syster I give xx^s Also to Robert my none v $iiij^d$, And to Will(iam) his brother as muche, And to Richard my other none likewise v $iiij^d$, The rest of my goodes unbequeathed, my debts being paid I give to Agnes my wife Bartholomew, maria & Jane my three youngest(?) chyldren to be esvally devyded amonge(?) them, And one of them to enjoy the others p(ar)t if they dy before they come to that age that they shuld receyve(?) the same, I will that my daughters have their p(ar)tes delyvered unto them at xiiij yeres of their age, And if it chence my wife to marry w(i)th in the same yeres and before the same delyvered their pore(i)ons then I will that her husband and she put in sufficient sureties, that the same porecons shall be well kept & suerly delyvered at their yeres apoynted or els to delyver the same out of hand to my overseers for the use of my chyldren, And wher they are certen implemetes in my house As a grear spitt An Iron pott & pothenses, the greakest caowther A Table trestels & a forme and a grear chest my will is that they shall remaine ^{as} stinders(?) to the house w(i)thout any alienating of any that shall have occupy & enjoy the same house from tyme to tyme for ever, I make Agnes my wife, Bartholomew mary & Jane my three chyldren my executors together & jointly, And I make Bartholomew Bowdocke p(ar)son of Aldbury John Cooke & Thomas Byenoll myne overseers And give to eche of them for their paynes v $iiij^d$, And that this my last will bee(?) witnesses(?) their underwrittes(?)
